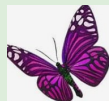


The Civic Mayor of Croydon's Fundraising Gala Dinner

These Dementia Friendly screenings aim to make cinema more accessible by providing a fun and inclusive experience to enable people living with dementia, their families and carers to attend the cinema in a safe and welcoming environment.

The lights are left on low, there are no adverts or trailers and the audience is allowed to move around or even sing along to any musical numbers if they would like to.

Admission is £6 on the door for people with dementia (carers are free). Free tea, coffee and biscuits will be available before the screening.

Director: James Algar-Samuel Armstrong, Ford Beebe Jr. 1940 USA 124 mins.
Disney's celebrated animated classical music anthology features the works of Bach, Tchaikovsky and Beethoven, in the portrayal of Greek gods and goddesses, dinosaurs and Mickey Mouse as the Sorcerer's Apprentice.


WHO FRAMED ROGER RABBIT (PG)
Tue 2 June at 11am
Director: Robert Zemeckis 1988 USA/UK 104 mins.
This fantastic mixture of live action and animation tells the story of how, in a world where humans and "toons" co-exist, private eye Eddie Valiant reluctantly agrees to help cartoon rabbit Roger, who has been framed for murder.

GHOST (12A)

Director: Jerry Zucker 1990 USA 126 mins.
A sleeper hit at the time of its release, the film follows the ghost of banker Sam Wheat as he tries to ensure the safety of his girlfriend Molly from the man who arranged his murder - with the help of charlatan psychic Oda Mae Brown (played by the Oscar-winning Whoopi Goldberg).

FAME (15)
Tue 4 August at 11am
Director: Alan Parker 1980 USA 134 mins.
Set in New York's High School of Performing Arts, Fame follows a disparate group of students from different backgrounds as they audition and then study at the school. We see how they progress across four years of study, as they aim to make it big.
